# Forward

Established in 1971, Sipajhar College, the only higher Educational institution of the south-west part of Darrang District of Assam having completed 31 years of its existence with glorious contribution to the academic and socio-cultural life of the vast area of Darrang and eastern part of Kamrup District. It was in response to the Long felt needs of the economically backward but educationally forward looking people of the locality to bring the light of higher education within the reach of the deserving student community that Sipajhar College established. Initially setup as an Arts College where classes began formally on 16 th August, 1971, the dream to introduce Science faculty is yet to be realised even after a glorious existence. It is a matter of pride that the college has successfully celebrated Silver Jubilee in the year 1997.

Situated in the village Bhukthabary at Sipajhar adjacent to the National High Way 52, the academic Jurisdiction of the college extends up to a radius of 50 kms. Boundary by the mighty Brahmaputra of the south, Kalaigam on the North, Mangaldai on the east and the Kamrup District in the west.

The College is affiliated to the Gauhati University and was brought under 2 (F) if U. G. C. in 1997. As the pioneer institution of higher education of the locality the management of Sipajhar College has ..... benefitted from the co-operation and active guidance of the people of the locality. Every effort is being made to provide the students of the college with all modern amenities like Computer, internet and a modern up to date Library.

## Cources of Study

1. Two year Higher Secondary Arts Course.
2. Three year Degree Arts Course.

### Subjests for H. S. Course :-

**Compulsory Course :-** English and Assamese (M I L).  
 Besides the Compulsory Subjects a student May offer four elective subjects at least two from each group. Among them one subject will be 4th subject.

### Elective Subjects :-

- Group A :-** Economics, Political Science, Logic  
**Group B :-** Education, advance Assamese, Geo-  
 graphy, History.

### Subjects for T. D. C. Course :

**Compulsory subjects :** 1. English 2. Assamese (M I L)

Besides the Compulsory subjects a student may offer two elective subjects form the two groups taking one from each group.

**Group A :-** Economic, Elective Assamese, History, Philosophy.

**Group B :-** Political Science, Education, Geography.

The Students may offer one subject as major from the followings.

3. **Major Course :-** English, Assamese, Economics, Political Science, Geography, History, Education and Philosophy.

Major Course is strictly limited to the meritories students. and the selection for major Course will be done by the department Concerned. The test for the major selection will be held as per the notification of the Head or the deptt concerned.

4. The College has been inperuting Computer education since 2001. The necessary information regarding this Computer Course is available at College Office.

5. Extension education centre is going to be started from this academic session. Our College is one of the 15 Colleges Selected by the G U for encouraging the students Community for self reliance on an experimental basis.
6. **National Service Scheme (NSS)** : Students can anroll themselves in NSS. of College which begins with its academic section.
7. The College has its own Academic Calendar in keeping with the academic. Calender of G. U. According to this Calendar, Annual, midterm and unit test will be held by the college during the full course of the study. Apart from these, The other important works are performed according to Academic Calendar.

The College prospectus along with the application form will be available for the students at the College office In Payment of Rs. 25/- only.

Admission will be done strictly on merit basis. However, there are reservation facilities for the students belongs to SC, ST, OBC, MOBC and physically handicapped students as per Govt rules.

A few seats are reserved for the students having outstanding performance in the feild of sports, culture and socialservice.

The admission Committee looks after the admission procedure.

At the time of admission the students will have to produce.

a) Original pass certificate and Marksheet. HSLC admit and character certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.

b) Caste certificate if applicable.

c) Certificate of other extra curricular activity.

d) gap cartificate

e) certificate from the concerning authority for physically handicapped and others.

\* (f) Two copies of recent pass port size photo graph. Candidate selected should get admitted themselves on the day of admission by paying the required amount of fee fixed by the authority.

Selected but absence candidate will have to forfeit his claim from admission.

Regular classes will be held from the date notified by the principal.

## **CLASS ATTENDANCE**

Students must attend at least 75% of total classes held annually. otherwise he/she will be treated as non Collegiate/dis collegiate and will not be allowed to appear in the Annual/Final examination.

## **Identity Card**

No student will be considered to be a benefit one unless he or she possesses identity card only signed by the Principal. He or She will have to produce his/her identity card at any moment when asked by the Principal or other teachers.

## **Library Facilities**

Sipajhar College provides the required library facilities to the students and teacher as well. The library building is well equipped and constructed on U G C grant. only the bonifide members are allowed to use the library, according to the rules framed. A good number of books, Journals, Periodicals, news papers also are available for

the readers. The library has also a Book Bank for the benefit of the poor and meritorious students. A student has to deposit Rs 50/- (fifty) as library caution money for the full course of study. Books are to be returned within 15 days failing which a fine of 10 paise per book per day is imposed. A borrower is personally responsible for any kind of damage caused of the book while it is in his/her possession. In addition to that all the departments have their own Libraries specially for the major students.

## **The College Magazine**

The "Sipajhar College Magazine" is annually published by the students Union. It is prepared by an editorial board consisting of members taken both from teaching staff and the students.

General rules to be followed by the students

The first and foremost duty of a student inside the College Campus is to maintain discipline Punctuality, and order as framed by the College authority. They must maintain discipline both out wordly and inwordly. They must be bound to Create such an academic situation which is in-putted to be conducive to the alround progress of the institution. For this purpose, College authority has formulated some specific rules and regulations which are totally imperative on the students. Any kind of violation of these rules may lead to the disciplinary action to the college authority. Under such action a student may be issued compulsory transfer certificate, expelled from the institution, and face any other punishment deemed by the College authority.

The power of taking disciplinary action for the violation of the rule is vested with the principal, and his decision is final.
