COURSE DETAILS

HIGHER SECONDARY ARTS :

Sipajhar College offers the Higher Secondary (H.S) course only in the Arts stream. It is a two year programme meant for students who have passed the Class X examination from any State Board or Council as accepted by the Ministry of Education of the Govt. of India. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- ❖ Admission to B.A./ B.Sc. 1st Semester and H.S. 1st year Arts, will be done entirely **ONLINE** for the session 2021-22 in view of the prevailing conditions of COVID 19.
- ❖ The students are to apply online at the Online Admission link shared in the College Website.
- ❖ The following are the mandatory requirements for admission:
 - ◆ Bank Account of the Applicant
 - ◆ Valid Email ID of the applicant
 - ◆ Mobile No. of the Applicant linked to the Bank A/C
- ❖ All Government grants will be directly credited to the account of the applicant.
- ❖ The students must furnish any of the following supporting documents to prove their domicile of Assam:
PRC/ Voter ID/NRC/ Adhar Card/BPL Card/Birth Certificate/ Pass Port
- ❖ While submitting the forms online, the students must upload the documents as mentioned in the online application form.
- ❖ All Students will be eligible to avail the scheme for Free Admission for the session 2021-22 in view of the COVID -19 pandemic as announced by State Government.

- ❖ After the completion of the application process, the **Merit List** and the **Cut Offs** for each subject will be released in the ONLINE ADMISSION PORTAL.
- ❖ Selection of the candidates for admission will be done by the Selection Committee. The Committee also reserves the right to modify the subjects chosen by the candidates depending on the availability of seats.
- ❖ The allotment of Major Subjects will be decided by Heads of respective departments solely on the basis of Merit, and seats will be filled on first-come-first-served basis.
- ❖ Admission is given purely on the basis of merit but a few seats are reserved for the physically challenged students and for those belonging to SC/ST as per Govt. rules.
- ❖ A few seats are also earmarked for students having extraordinary competence in sports, culture and community service.

DOCUMENTS TO BE UPLOADED ALONG WITH APPLICATION FORM

- ❖ Relevant certificates for the physically handicapped students issued by competent authorities like the Social Welfare Department, Govt. of Assam.

- ❖ Caste Certificate if applicable.

STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

- ❖ The college provides free meditation and yoga classes for students by incorporating the same into the college routine. It is mandatory from 4th semester onwards. Other interested students may also attend. These classes are conducted by trained meditation experts from the local centre of the Prajapita Brahma Kumari.
- ❖ The NGO SARSA in collaboration with IQAC's Extension Education Cell conducts Drama workshops and summer camps for the students where training in all aspects of Dramatic performance is provided by experts.
- ❖ Karate training is available for both girls and boys. Girls are trained during college hours and boys are provided training after college hours.
- ❖ The College has an indoor sports training centre with a fully equipped gymnasium. A qualified trainer is appointed by the college to provide training to the students.

- ❖ The college has a canteen within the campus which provides quality food at very reasonable rates.

Health Care Centre :

The College has a fully equipped Health Care Centre with a doctor from the Sipajhar Community Health Centre on Call during College working hours.

Modern Facilities :

The latest educational facilities and opportunities like access to the Internet are provided here. Teaching aids such as OHPs, LCD projectors, Computers and Microphones have been made available to all the departments.

INFORMATION CUM CAREER GUIDANCE AND COUNSELLING CELL (ICGC)

This is a student welfare service aimed at providing the students with guidance and counseling to cope with personal and social problems and also to provide an exposure to career opportunities. The cell organises awareness programmes for personality development and workshops to provide information on career avenues and prospects

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS)

Established in 1993 to inculcate social consciousness and a sense of responsibility, discipline and dignity of labour among the youths the National Service Scheme (NSS) is a voluntary organisation of college students under the Union Ministry of Human Resource Development. Students can enroll themselves in the NSS unit of the college at the beginning of the academic session. The college unit of the NSS takes up a number of social service programmes with active participation of the people of the locality.

BHARAT SCOUTS AND GUIDES

The Unit of Bharat Scouts and Guides was constituted at Sipajhar College in 2009. Since then, it has been rendering a fruitful service to the college participating in all its auspicious occasions. Besides, the unit also involves itself in different occasions and activities arranged by the State as well as the Central Government



STUDENTS' AID FUND

The College has an aid fund for economically weaker students. However, as the number of such

students is very high, it is not possible to provide financial assistance to all such students. Hence the college has set up a Book Bank which provides books to the needy students (In addition to the ones they are entitled to borrow from the Central Library)

AWARDS AND PRIZES :

- ❖ The college has a "Best Graduate Award" for the student who tops the University examination from the College. All students securing a CGPA of 10 in the University final examination are also be suitably awarded by the College.
- ❖ The Sipajhar College Teachers' Co-operative Society awards the Best Graduate of the College.
- ❖ "**Dr. Sarada Nair Memorial Award**" is given to the student securing highest marks in English (Major) among the students of Sipajhar College in the final examination of GU.
- ❖ The college has "**Udipta Bharadwaj Memorial Trust**" instituted in 2018 which provides cash awards and citations to two selected students of the college.
- ❖ "**Purnakanta Hazarika Memorial Award**" is given annually to the student who gets the highest marks in History (Major) in the University finals from the college.
- ❖ **Khagen Deka Memorial Award** is given to the best graduate of science stream of Sipajhar College securing not less than 80% marks in the Final Examination.
- ❖ The department of Political Science offers a **cash award** to all students who secure 1st class in the University final examinations from the College.
- ❖ The college offers **three prizes to the 3 best departments** participating in the cultural procession taken out as part of the College Week.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

- ❖ The College Library is the hub of the academic activities supporting the institution's mission of achieving excellence in education and research.
- ❖ Sipajhar College has a modern computerized library with an impressive collection of around Twenty thousand books, several local and national newspapers and more than two dozen journals, both national and international.
- ❖ The Central Library, Sipajhar College provides digital library services using DSpace software, through which students can access the library anywhere anytime (from the current session).
- ❖ It also has a good collection of magazines, e-resources like CD/DVD, e-journals, e-books, bibliographic databases, etc.



- ❖ All students, faculties and employees of the College are entitled to make use of the Library facilities. The library also renders service to people from outside the college community after receiving due permission from the college authority
- ❖ The library with its semi-open access system and spacious reading area provides an atmosphere favorable to the excitement of mental discovery. Students are always encouraged to do the optimum utilization of the library resources by creating a user-friendly atmosphere.
- ❖ The library also provides access to e-resources to the teachers and students of the College through UGC-INFLIBNET N-List programme. The library remains open from 10 A.M. to 4 P.M. on all working days.
- ❖ A student will have to apply on a separate form supplied by the librarian to access the library facilities.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LIBRARY

- ❖ *All members have to record their name, address and time of arrival and departure and put their signature in the Register at the library entrance.*
- ❖ *All bags and carrying cases must be left in the shelves located at the entrance of the library.*
- ❖ Disruptive behaviour, such as creating loud noise, loud talking, screaming, or banging on computer keyboards are strictly prohibited.
- ❖ Consuming food or beverages inside the library is strictly prohibited.
- ❖ **Each student is allowed to borrow two books at a time.**
- ❖ **Books are issued to students for a period of 15 (fifteen) days. They may be reissued for a period of another 15 days.**
- ❖ **An overdue charge of Rs. 1.00 only per day is levied if a book is kept beyond the due date.**
- ❖ **Books on loan with members can be recalled at any time, without assigning any reason thereof.**

Departmental Library-All the departments of the college have well-stocked departmental libraries for the use of students having major in the concerned subject.

WOMEN'S HOSTEL

A full-fledged Women's Hostel having all modern amenities has been functioning for the last decade and offer accommodation for girls. It has a seat capacity of 60 and the students are allotted seats on the basis of merit. However, women coming from remote places with inadequate



transport and communication facilities are given priority. A separate form for admission to the hostel can be obtained from the hostel warden on the day of college admission. It is to be filled and submitted to the warden at the time of admission.

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BOARDERS OF THE WOMEN'S HOSTEL

- ❖ Boarders must pay their monthly mess dues on time.
- ❖ No Boarder is allowed to leave the hostel without prior permission from the hostel Superintendent.
- ❖ Visitors are allowed to meet a boarder only during visiting hours.
- ❖ All hostel property like furniture, utensils, electrical appliances etc should be treated properly and in case of any damage, the matter should be brought to the notice of the superintendent immediately.
- ❖ Use of unauthorised electrical appliances such as heaters and irons are strictly prohibited.
- ❖ Expulsion from the college hostel implies expulsion from the college and vice versa.
- ❖ The hostel remains closed during all vacations.
- ❖ A student may stay as a hostel guest during examinations, with prior permission from the hostel superintendent. Such a guest can stay for not more than a month and she will have to pay Rs 200 as seat rent to the college.
- ❖ Any student staying in the hostel for more than a month will be treated as a regular boarder.

STUDENTS' IDENTITY CARD

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES
