# ACADEMIC COURSES OFFERED

## THE COLLEGE OFFERS THE FOLLOWING REGULAR COURSES OF STUDY:

1. Two year Higher Secondary Course in Arts under Assam Higher Secondary Educational Council.
2. Three year Degree Course in Arts (six semesters) under Gauhati University
3. Post graduate course in Assamese under Gauhati University has been introduced from the academic session 2015-16 with an intake capacity of 20.

## DETAILS

### HIGHER SECONDARY ARTS:

Sipajhar College offers the Higher Secondary (H.S) course in the Arts stream. It is a Two Year Programme meant for students who have passed the Class X exam from any standard Board or Council as accepted by the Ministry of Education of the Govt. of India. The college accepts students belonging to all standard boards and councils.

The combination of subjects and the compulsory subjects offered at the Higher Secondary level are as follows:

Note : (i) MIL (Assamese)/Alt. English, English & Environmental Studies are compulsory for all students.

(ii) Students can select 4 (four) Elective subjects (1 of them will be fourth elective subject as per AHSEC rule) from the above mentioned subjects.

### B.A. (SEMESTER SYSTEM):

The college offers Under Graduate course of 6 semester in arts under Gauhati University leading to the degree of Bachelor of Arts (Major and General).

### SELECTION FOR MAJOR COURSES:

As the available seats for major course of study in each department is limited, the selection for major course of study in each department will be done solely on the basis of merit and seats will be filled on first-come-first-served basis as per merit list on the day of admission. However, a selection test shall be conducted by the Selection Committee of the respective Departments within fifteen days from the commencement of the classes. Once seats are filled no claims will be entertained.

### DISTANCE AND OPEN LEARNING:

Sipajhar College provides facilities and opportunities under the Distance and Open Learning System. The college is a partner institute of Krishna Kanta Handique State Open University (KKHSOU) and offers regular weekend classes for various courses. Renowned professionals and academicians take classes for the programmes. Under KKHSOU's Convergence Scheme, the College offers the following courses :

### ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

- The College prospectus and application form for admission to the college will be available to students at the college office. The dates for submission of forms and interview for admission will be notified on the college notice board, in the college website and in the local dailies.
- Photocopies of mark sheets & certificates must be submitted with the admission form. The original testimonials are to be produced at the time of interview.
- Admission is given purely on the basis of merit but a few seats are reserved for the physically challenged students and for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC/MOBC as per Govt. rules.
- A few seats are also earmarked for students having extraordinary competence in sports, culture and community service.
- Selected candidates should take admission on the day notified by the college by paying the fee in full, fixed by the college authorities. Regular classes will commence from 1st of August, 2018.

### DOCUMENTS TO BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

- a) Original Mark Sheet of last qualifying examination.
- b) Admit card and original Pass Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
- c) Certificate related to extra curricular activities.
- d) Gap certificate (if required but not exceeding a gap of 2 years).
- e) Recent passport size photograph (two copies).
- f) Relevant certificates for the physically challenged students issued by competent authorities like Social Welfare Department, Govt. of Assam.
- g) Proof of Age.
- h) Caste Certificate if applicable.

### GOVT. DIRECTIVES FOR ADMISSIONS:

Students who are provided free admission shall have their original mark sheets stamped and signed by the College authority.

Duly filled Anti Ragging undertaking provided with the form must be submitted at the time of admission.

Students applying for free admission will have to provide Income Certificate from competent authority as a proof of income not exceeding Rs.1 Lakh per year.

**STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES:**

- The college provides free meditation and yoga classes for students by incorporating the same into the college routine. It is mandatory from 4<sup>th</sup> semester onwards. Other interested students can also attend.
- These classes are conducted by trained meditation experts from the local centre of the Prajapita Brahma Kumari Centre.
- The NGO SARSA in collaboration with IQAC's Extension Education Cell conducts drama workshops and summer camps for the students where training in all aspects of dramatic performance is provided by experts with NSD degrees.
- Karate training is available for both girls and boys. Girls are trained during college hours and boys are provided training after college hours.
- The college has an indoor sports training centre with a fully equipped gymnasium.
- A qualified trainer is employed by the college to provide training to the students.
- The college has a canteen within the campus which provides quality food at very reasonable rates.
- Health Care Centre : The College has a fully equipped Health Care Centre with a Doctor from the Sipajhar Community Health Centre on call during College working hours.
- Modern Facilities : The latest in educational facilities and opportunities are provided here like access to Internet. Teaching aids such as OHPs, LCD projectors, Computers and Microphones have been made available to all the departments.

**OTHER FACILITIES AVAILABLE:**

- A Language Lab with a fully qualified teacher imparts 6 months certificate course in communicative English.
- A Modern Computer Lab has been set up which is equipped with 21 computers with Internet connectivity.
- Fully functional Digital Classroom and Digital Library.
- Information cum Career Guidance and Counselling Cell ( ICGC) is a student welfare service aimed at providing the students with guidance and counselling to cope with personal and social problems and to provide wide exposure to career opportunities. The cell organises awareness programmes for personality development and workshops to provide information on career avenues and prospects.



### NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (NSS):

Established in 1993 to inculcate social consciousness and a sense of responsibility, discipline and dignity of labour among the youth the National Service Scheme (NSS) is a voluntary organisation of college students under the Union Ministry of Human Resource Development. Students can enrol themselves in the NSS unit of the college at the beginning of the academic session. The college unit of the NSS takes up a number of social service programmes with active participation of the people of the locality, social service programmes with active participation of the people of the locality.

### BHARAT SCOUTS AND GUIDES:

The Unit of Bharat Scouts and Guides was constituted at Sipajhar College in 2006. Since then, it has been rendering a fruitful service to the college participating in all its auspicious occasions. Besides, the unit also involves itself in different occasions and activities arranged by the State as well as the Central Government.



### NATURE CLUB:

A Nature Club has been formed which focuses on holistic and sustainable development of the surroundings and to make students aware about protection of nature and environment. Every year the World Environment Day is observed under the aegis of this club with full cooperation from the teachers, management and students.



### SPORTS CLUB:

A Sports Club was formed with the intention of promoting students' interest in all types of sports and to provide an opportunity for the students to participate in sporting activities. A Badminton Club has already started its activities with students and teachers as its members.

### RED RIBBON CLUB (RRC):

Sipajhar College has a "Red Ribbon Club" functioning under the aegis of the Assam State Aids Control Society (ASACS), Khanapara. The main purpose of the club is to create awareness among the students on the necessity of voluntary blood donation, blood testing, blood grouping, AIDS, HIV avoidance of intoxicants etc. The club also offers counselling and advice on preventive measures. Membership for students is free and voluntary.

### STUDENTS' AID FUND:

The college has an aid fund for economically weaker students. However, since the number of such students is very high, financial assistance to be provided to all such students is not possible. Hence the college has set up a Book Bank which provides books to the needy students (In addition to the ones they are entitled to borrow from the Central Library).





### AWARDS AND PRIZES:

- The college has a "Best Graduate Award" for the student who is the topper in the University exams from the College. All students securing a CGPA of 10 in the University final exams will also be suitably awarded by the College
- The Sipajhar College Teachers' Co-operative Society gives an award to Best Graduate of the College.
- Dr. Sarada Nair Memorial Awards are given to two students getting highest marks in English (Major) of the College.
- Purnakanta Hazarika Memorial Award is given annually to the student who gets the highest Marks in History (Major) in the University finals from the college.
- The Department of Political Science offers a cash award to all students who secure 1st class in the University final examinations from the College.
- The college offers three prizes to the 3 best departments participating in the cultural procession taken out as part of the College Week .

### LIBRARY:

The Sipajhar College Library has around Nineteen thousand books, several local and national newspapers and more than two dozen journals, both national and international. It follows the open access system with books being lent out through requisition slips. Digitalization of the Library has already been

started. The Library is equipped with INFLIBNET services. Besides providing internet facilities the library users also have access to reprographic services and photocopies of resources available in the library and reference section.

### RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE LIBRARY:

- Books are issued as per schedule prepared by the Librarian
- Books are issued for 15 days and renewed for another 15 days.
- Thereafter a fine of 1 rupee per day will be realised.
- Personal books are not allowed inside the library.
- There are two reading rooms, one for the students and the other for the teachers.
- There is a Book Bank which provides books to the needy students (In addition to the ones they are entitled to borrow from the Central Library).

### DEPARTMENTAL LIBRARY:

All the departments of the college have well- stocked departmental libraries for the use of students having major in the concerned subject.

### WOMEN'S HOSTEL:

A full-fledged Women's Hostel having all modern amenities has been functioning for the last decade and offers accommodation for girls. It has a seat capacity of 60 and the students are allotted seats on merit basis. However women coming from remote places with inadequate transport and communication facilities are given priority. A separate form for admission to the hostel, can be obtained from the hostel warden on the day of college admission. It is to be filled and submitted to the warden at the time of admission.



### RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR BOARDERS OF THE WOMEN'S HOSTEL:

1. Boarders must pay their monthly mess dues on time.
2. No Boarder is allowed to leave the hostel without prior permission from the hostel superintendent.
3. Visitors are allowed to meet a boarder only during visiting hours and in the visiting room .
4. All hostel property like furniture, utensils, electrical appliances etc should be treated properly and in the event of any damage the matter should be brought to the notice of the superintendent immediately.
5. Use of unauthorised electrical appliances such as heaters and irons are strictly prohibited.
6. Expulsion from the college hostel implies expulsion from the college and vice versa.
7. The hostel remains closed during all vacations.
8. A student may stay as a hostel guest during examinations , with prior permission from the hostel superintendent. Such a guest can stay for not more than a month and she will have to pay Rs 200 as seat rent to the college.
9. Any student staying in the hostel for more than a month will be treated as a regular boarder.



### WOMEN'S CELL:

The college has a functioning Women's Cell that works in close coordination with the Women's Study Centre of Gauhati University. The Cell regularly arranges health camps, workshops and lectures on women's health issues by leading health practitioner. The Cell is actively involved in observing World Literacy Day and International Women's Day.

### STUDENTS' UNION:

The students' union of the college is a constitutionally elected body that enjoys a term of one year. It is entrusted with all the activities related to the interests and welfare of the students of the college. The students' union has its own room and plays a proactive role in the affairs of the college. It is entrusted with the responsibilities of organizing the annual All Assam Debate Competition, the College Week and Fresher's Social etc. The college authority provides assistance and co-operation to the Students' Union in all its activities.

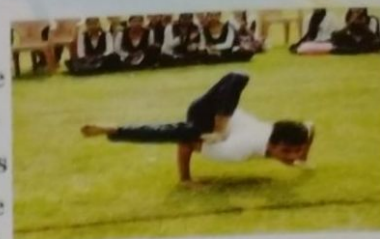
### STUDENTS' IDENTITY CARD:

The college identity card is issued to the students at the time of admission. The duly filled in identity card authenticated by the signature of the Principal of the college is to be carried by all students. In case of any loss or damage to the card, the matter should be immediately reported to the Principal and a duplicate will be issued on payment of the prescribed fee.



### CO- CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

Games & Sports : Built with UGC assistance under the XI Plan the college has an Indoor Sports Training Centre with state-of- the- art- equipment. It provides facilities for indoor sports and games. Facilities for outdoor games like Football and Cricket are also available. The process of construction of an Outdoor Stadium has already been started.



### COLLEGE MAGAZINE:

### STUDENTS' TRAVELLING CONCESSION:

Students of the college are entitled to concessions on travel home and back during vacation, for travelling on academic tours organised by the college and for travel in connection with college activities.

### INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC):

The college has a functional IQAC Cell which looks after the following activities related to the alround development of the College.

- 1) The IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) has taken up implementation of the UGC recommended Performance Based Self Appraisal System.
- 2) The IQAC has taken up the preparation of Teaching Plan, Schedule, Annual Plan etc. as per UGC / NAAC recommendation.
- 3) The IQAC has made a provision for taking online feed -back from the students of the college on various aspects of teaching and learning. The feed - back is analysed and report made known to the teachers.
4. Maroi Bijuli-Bari village has been adopted by the IQAC. It will be developed into a model village in a phased manner. The teachers & college authorities have taken steps for the development of the academic environment of the schools located in the village and in the surrounding areas.



### CODE OF CONDUCT:

- It is mandatory for the students to come to the college in the prescribed uniform and to carry identity cards at all times. Indulging in ragging in any form inside and outside the college is strictly prohibited. Any student found doing so will be dealt with as per directives of the Courts.
- Students are strictly prohibited from damaging college property. The cost of any such damage will be recovered from the student /guardian.
- The college campus is a No Smoking, No Tobacco, No Plastic, No Alcohol, No Drugs zone.
- The use of Mobile Phones inside the college campus is strictly prohibited and phones (handset) used inside the college will be confiscated.
- All students should read the notice board regularly.
- Minimum attendance of 75% is mandatory for appearing in the Council and University examinations. Students remaining absent for more than 10 days at a stretch will have their names taken off the attendance registers. To get their names re-entered in the register an application addressed to the HOD countersigned by the guardian and supported by a medical certificate will be considered. 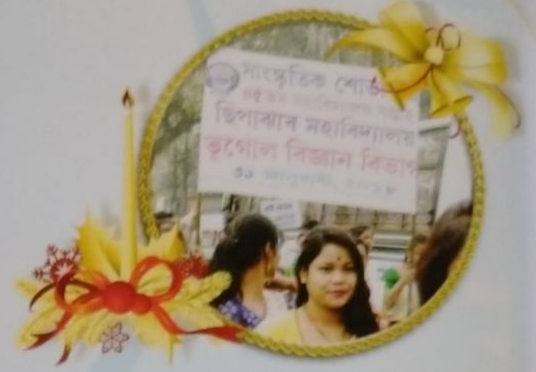

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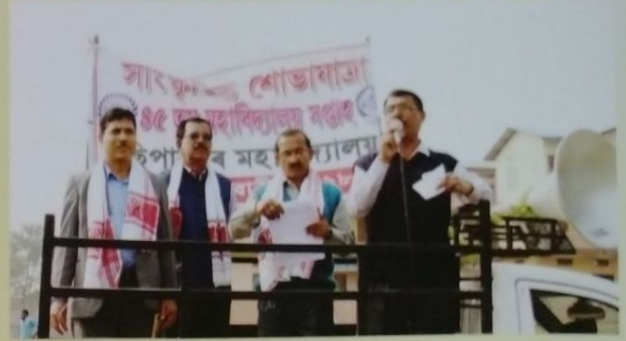
